**The following technology is *highly recommended* in order to make your All-State experience smooth and uninterrupted:**

- A laptop/computer with a camera (phones and tablets often have intermittent connectivity)
- An external USB microphone – internal microphones do not produce the best sound quality
- Headphones/ear pods
- [The Zoom Client](#) – Zoom is available for Windows and MacOS and can be installed on each. The web client does not allow all of the features that the installed client does.
- Ethernet internet connection – being plugged into an ethernet port often provides more stable internet connection than WiFi.

### **Things To Bring To Each Virtual Session:**

- Instrument and all necessary accessories
- Pencil and paper for notetaking
- Any music that was distributed
- Folding Music Stand

### **Session Etiquette**

- Test all Zoom and your technology beforehand to avoid any issues on the day of the event.
- Please make sure your camera is on – the clinicians want to interact with you and see you performing!
- Students should stay muted as to avoid distracting other musicians and the clinicians.
- Try to set up in a quiet and well-lit room away from distractions so you can hear. Make sure that you set yourself and your instrument up away in such a way that the clinicians can see your full body and instrument position.
- Join each Zoom session at least 10 minutes early and be prompt to all workshops.
