Guidelines

The Florida Orchestra Association Hall of Fame was established to honor Florida orchestra educators who have exemplified outstanding achievement, as well as a lifetime of service and leadership to Florida schools. The criteria for the FOA Hall of Fame are as follows:

- The nominee has been an active member of the Florida Orchestra Association throughout his or her career.
- The nominee has at least twenty-five years of teaching experience, the majority of which were served in Florida.
- The nominee has made significant contributions to the music education profession in Florida.

Nominating Procedure

1. To nominate a candidate for a Hall of Fame Award, please complete the form below.
2. In addition, please submit no more than two (2) single-spaced typed pages detailing the nominee's accomplishments. You may also submit up to three (3) pages of supporting materials you think will be helpful to the Awards Committee.
3. Nominations should be submitted by FOA members only.
4. Nominees and nominators will be notified of the results of the Awards Committee's deliberations.
5. The Awards Committee reserves the right to select multiple award recipients, as well as no award recipients. The deadline to submit nominations is June 30th.
