- 2. In addition, please submit no more than two (2) single-spaced typed pages detailing the nominee's accomplishments. You may also submit up to three (3) pages of supporting materials you think will be helpful to the Awards Committee.
- 3. Nominations should be submitted by FOA members only.
- 4. Nominees and nominators will be notified of the results of the Awards Committee's deliberations.
- 5. The Awards Committee reserves the right to select multiple award recipients, as well as no award recipients. The deadline to submit nominations is June 30<sup>th</sup>.
